HONOR SOCIETY INDUCTIONS

The National Art Honor Society Induction was held on February 27, 2018 at East Meadow High School. This is the fourth year that East Meadow High School and W.T. Clarke High School had a combined ceremony. The East Meadow High School chapter of the National Art Honor Society inducted all thirty two of its members due to their dedication to the visual arts as well as their overall academic status. Tri-M held its Induction Ceremony on Tuesday, March 6th, 2018. The Tri-M Induction Ceremony recognizes new and returning members to the Music Honor Society. The standards for membership include a performance of a NYSSMA Level 5 or 6 solo and attaining a grade above 90 (Level 6) or 95 (Level 5), academic scholarship, and community service. Students have been working toward these requirements all year. This year, 36 newly eligible students were inducted, bringing the membership to 94 students in grades 9 through 12. The music department is proud of the high achievements of our students and the time they give back through musical community service. The ceremony included performances, the Tri-M pledge, and guest speaker Mr. Michael Blutman, a successful musician and music alumnus of EMHS, with a reception afterwards that included more performances by all members of Tri-M.
